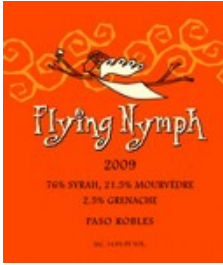

Cass 2009 Flying Nymph Paso Robles (13) 89



The 2009 Flying Nymph is a tasty Rhone blend of Syrah (76%), Mourvedre (21.5%) and Grenache (2.5%) It offers spicy black cherry aromas and is soft on the attack with flavors of red and blackberries, earth and pepper. It has a lush ripe texture, (14.8 alc) high acidity and nicely polished tannin on the finish. Lood Kotze, the young South African winemaker from Stellenbosch who took over winemaking responsibilities last year, is making his mark.
